Wind

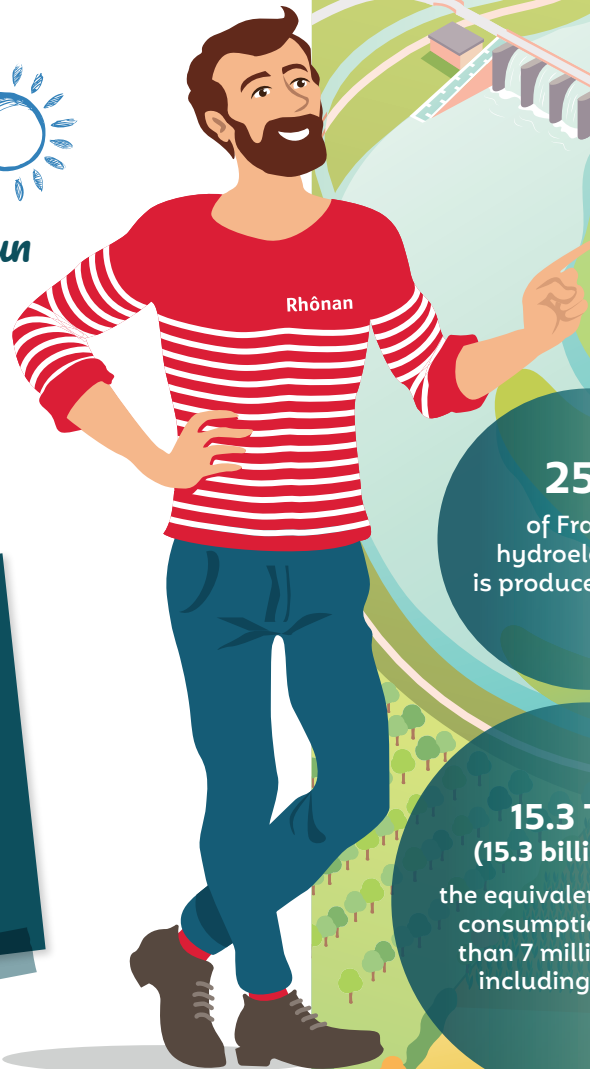
